In exceptional circumstances we may need to make a transfer of the grant direct to your account, in which case we would need bank details and a copy of a bank statement / letter no older than three months.

We reserve the right to withhold your grant if we find that any false information is supplied to the Charity.

We use your information for administration, analysis and research purposes. We will keep your details confidential and they will not be made public in any way, except as required by law.
